



What do we need to do before we visit?

Please make sure you do the following before your visit:

- Arrange transport
- Arrange a pre-visit to Woodlands Farm to complete your own risk assessments
- Check that you are bringing enough adults (see Booking Confirmation Sheet)
- Write to children's parents giving them information about the trip and what items children need to bring with them, e.g. money, food, clothing

How do we get there?

Main Entrance:

The 89 (Lewisham to Slade Green) and 486 (North Greenwich to Bexleyheath) buses stop right outside the farm. Our nearest train station is Welling. There is space to park coaches or minibuses either in the farm car park or on Shooters Hill, just outside.



Back Gate:

The farm has a back gate onto Garland Road. The 291 (Woolwich to the Woodlands Estate) bus stops near here. **NOTE:** if you are thinking about arriving via our back gate, please let us know as the gate is locked and we will need to meet you. Please be aware that it takes at least 10 minutes to walk through the farm from our back gate to our farmyard and Education Centre.

What do we need to bring?

All Year Round:

- Waterproof coat
- Wellies
- Spare shoes (trainers or boots) to change into
- Long sleeved top to protect arms
- Long trousers to protect from prickly plants
- Packed Lunch
- Morning snack (for younger children if necessary)
- Container of drink (ideally a refillable bottle)
- Pocket money for the Shop (£1-3 each)

Summer:

- Sun hat and sunglasses
- Warm layers
- Sun cream
- Extra water

Winter:

- Hat, gloves and scarf
- Warm socks
- A warm coat with a hood or hat

Individuals should carry appropriate medication where necessary. Hayfever sufferers are advised to take medication prior to their visit, particularly in the summer.
